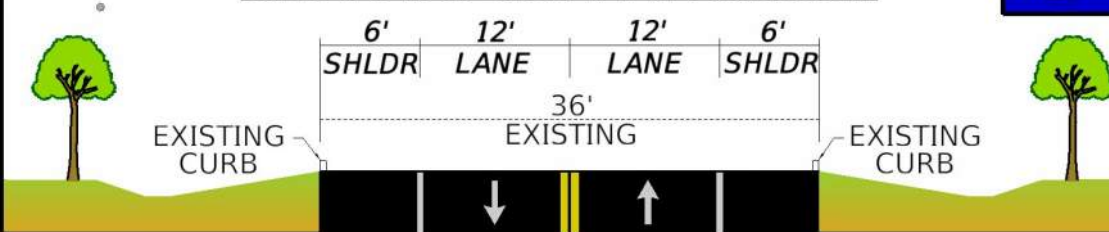

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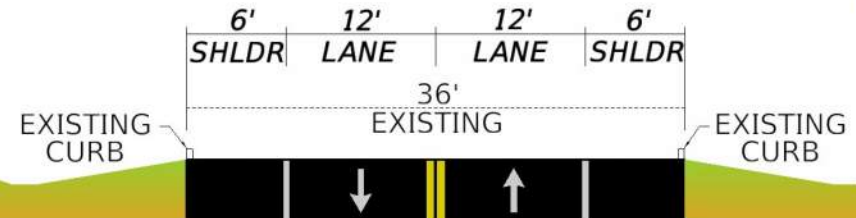

SR1 Access Analysis

White Oak Rd to Toll Plaza

Any new ramp location in this area would not meet spacing requirements and would create safety issues with weave near the toll plaza

Toll Plaza

White Oak

N. Little Creek

Exiting North Serving Ramps

Ramp adequately serve the existing and proposed industrial areas east of SR1

Lafferty to S. Little Creek

No opportunity based on existing ramp locations

N. Little Creek to White Oak Rd.

A new ramp could meet spacing requirements but would not reduce overall travel times on the network

S. Little Creek to N. Little Creek

Any new ramp options would not meet spacing requirements and introduce unsafe weaving conditions

SR1 Access Analysis

S. Little Creek to N. Little Creek SB On Ramp Options

- Creates an Undesirable Weave Condition between This On-Ramp and Puncheon Run Off-Ramp
- Ramp Spacing Requirement Would Not Be Met
- Requires Right-of-way Acquisition
- Requires Relocation of Existing Business

S. Little Creek to N. Little Creek NB On Ramp Options

- Requires Widening of SR1 for Acceleration Lane and Taper
- Requires Widening of SR1 NB Bridge Over North Little Creek Road
- Requires Right-of-way Acquisition
- Requires Relocation of Existing Residence and Business
- Ramp Spacing Requirement Would Not Be Met
- Ramp Access Would Only Be 900' Away From the Existing NB Ramp From North Little Creek Road



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SR1 Access Analysis



N. Little Creek to White Oak Rd. SB Off Ramp Options

- No Options

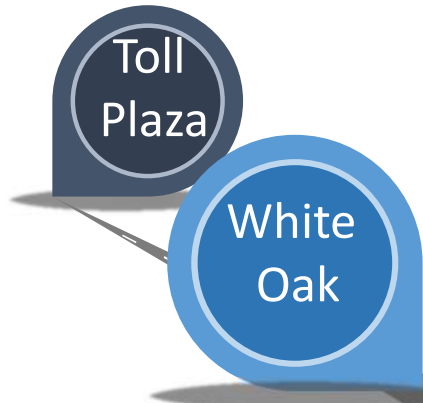
N. Little Creek to White Oak Rd. NB On Ramp Options

- Ramp From Horsepond Road Extended to SR1 NB
- Ramp Would Merge With SR1 Approximately 1000' South of White Oak Road
- Requires Widening of White Oak Road Bridge Over SR1
- Ramp Spacing Requirement Would Not Be Met
- Ramp Access Would Be 3,800' Away From the Existing NB Ramp From North Little Creek Road

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SR1 Access Analysis



White Oak Rd to Toll Plaza NB On Ramp Options

- Ramp From Garrison Oak Drive to SR1 NB
- This Ramp Location is Not Feasible Based on Proximity to the Toll Plaza

White Oak Rd to Toll Plaza SB Off Ramp Options

- Ramp From SR1 SB to White Oak Road
- This Ramp Location is Not Feasible Based on Proximity to the Toll Plaza
- No Direct Connection to Horsepond Road Extended Without Ramp Flyover of SR1
- Requires Right-of-way Acquisition

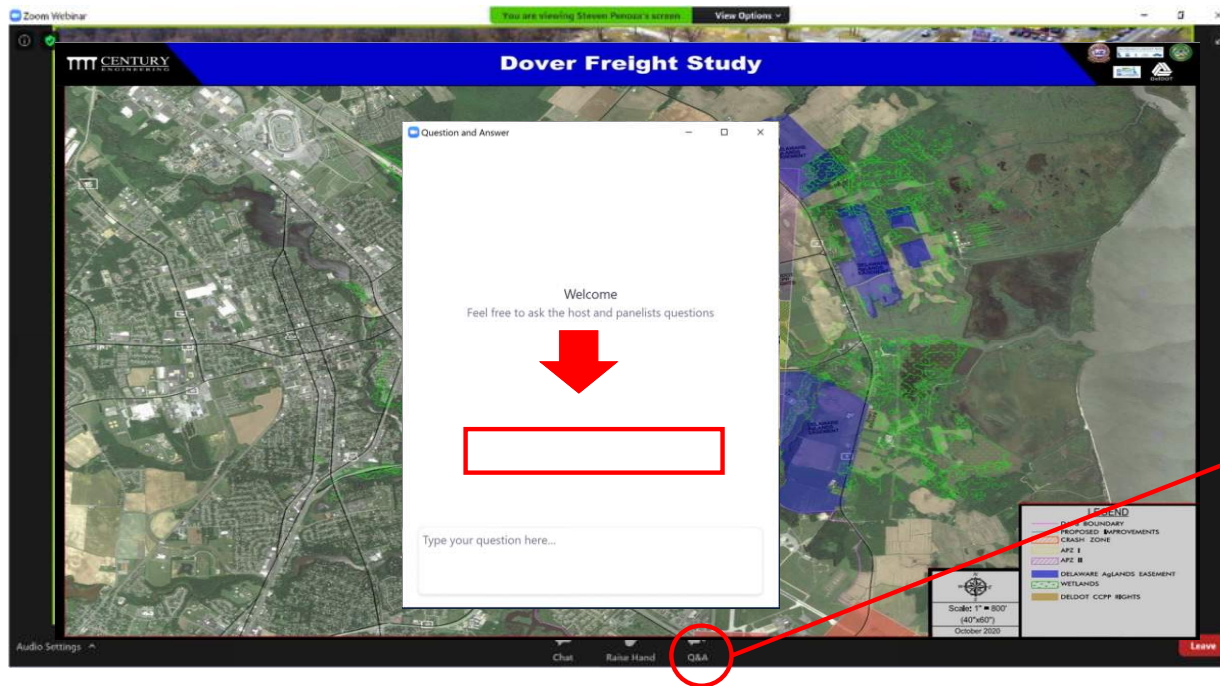
