

N. REHOBOTH BLVD/N. WALNUT ST CORRIDOR STUDY Public Input Meeting

The City of Milford and the Dover/Kent County Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) are performing a corridor study of N. Rehoboth Boulevard and N. Walnut Street between the Mispillion River and US113. The purpose of the study is to identify gaps in the pedestrian and bicycle network and provide recommendations to enhance bicycle and pedestrian safety in the immediate area. The final report and plan documents would be used to develop construction plans for future City and State capital projects.

The City will be hosting a public input meeting on <u>Wednesday, October</u> <u>25, 2023 from 6:00 PM to 8:00 PM</u> at the Public Works Facility, 180 Vickers Drive, Milford, DE. All parties of interest are invited to participate in the planning process.
